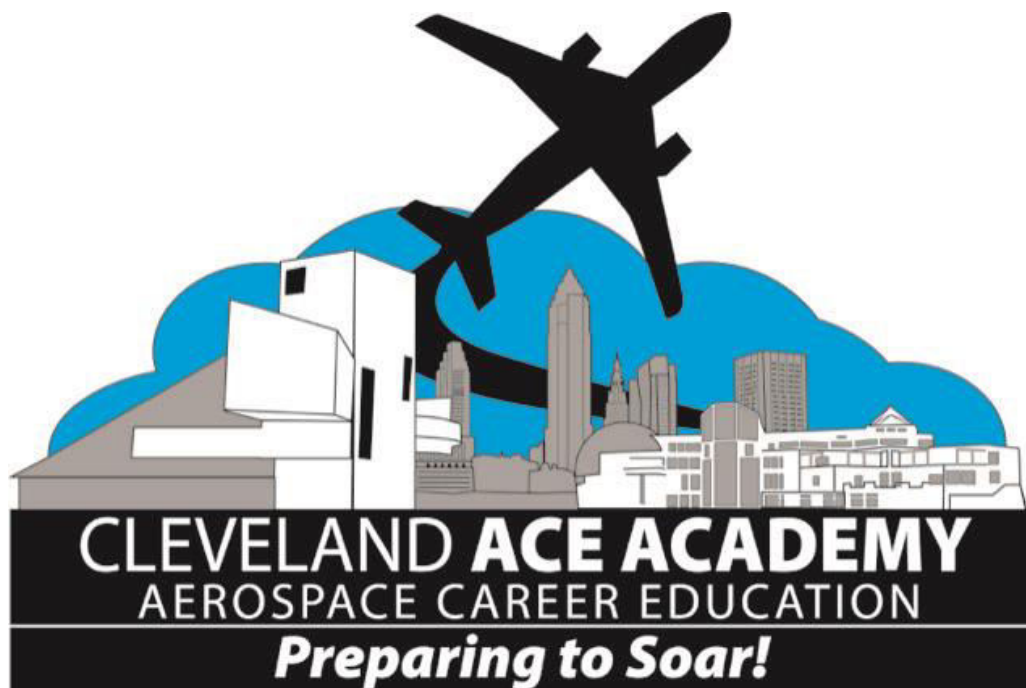

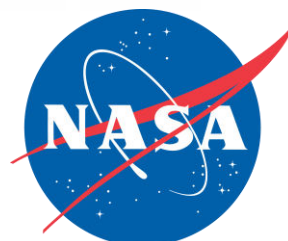

About the OBAP Cleveland ACE Academy

The Organization of Black Aerospace Professionals ACE Academy is a nationally recognized program co-sponsored by the Federal Aviation Administration. (FAA) and the National Black Coalition of Federal Aviation Employees (NBCFAE).

The purpose of Aerospace Career Education (ACE) is to offer first level exposure to the aerospace industry by providing aerospace career exploration for middle and high school students. Academy participants learn about Aerospace history, theory of flight, and other aerospace related subjects.

Overview

The Cleveland ACE schedule is designed to share with students a wide variety of career opportunities in Aerospace. Our goal is to focus on and contribute to the mission of our partner organizations. We provide an opportunity for students to receive hands-on experiences. ACE will help students see the value collaboration and education can have on their future success, regardless of the career they pursue. While spending each day with Aerospace Professionals, students will visit aerospace facilities, including museums and airports, and participate in activities designed to educate and inspire.

Activities

As a member of Cleveland ACE Academy you will:

- Meet professionals in the aerospace community
- Associate and work with other youth
- Learn basic aerodynamics
- Fly a Flight Simulator
- Study History with an emphasis on African Americans in Aerospace
- Gain a basic understanding of Commercial, Corporate, and Military Operations
- Learn qualities of leadership
- Operate unmanned aerial systems and remote-control vehicles, when available
- Take an orientation flight in an aircraft, weather and operations permitting

Admission Requirements

Admission is offered to students entering 8th-12th grade, ages **13 to 18** years old who have an interest in learning about aerospace. Students must be physically capable of participating in all activities.

- High standards of behavior and self-discipline are expected, and students must abide by all academy regulations.
- Parents or guardians must attend an orientation before programs begin. Details will be shared upon student acceptance.
